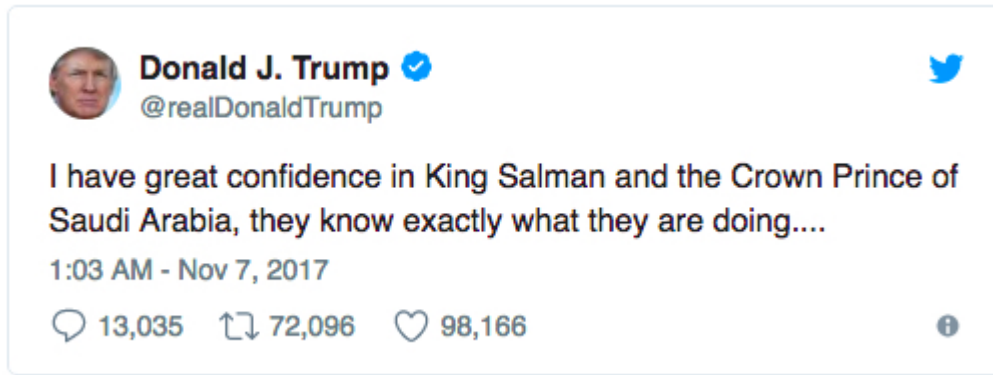
The only way to ‘enforce’ the Petrodollar; at least according to the Prussian playbook, was via war.

The Saudis also secretly bought CSS-2 ballistic missiles from China in the 80s. They also generously financed Pakistan's defence sector. Indirectly the Saudis were actively financing their future intentions through another state.

Obama's Iran negotiations appeared to be cause for concern for Saudi Arabia; so much so, that they were openly stating they had access to nukes. We also have the case of SA being the largest donor to the Clinton Foundation leading up to the 2016 election. The statement itself implies that the Muslim Brotherhood has been deeply embedded within the education system of Saudi Arabia. This is the same Muslim Brotherhood that is responsible for the birth of the terror organisations of Isis, Hamas and Al-Qaeda. It is the same Muslim Brotherhood that got its start in 1928 with Nazi Germany.

Origins of the Muslim Brotherhood:

The Muslim Brotherhood was formed in 1928 by Hassan al-Banna. Al-Banna was a fervent admirer of Adolph Hitler and his Nazi vision. He persistently wrote to Hitler and expressed his desire for the Nazi Party to collaborate with his version of Islam – the Muslim Brotherhood.

The Nazis and the Muslim Brotherhood became allies leading into WWII. Beginning as a secret arm of Nazi Intelligence in the Middle East, the Muslim Brotherhood grew to over 200,000 men by 1938, and two Muslim Waffen-SS Handschar divisions were formed, which fought for Hitler in the Middle East.

General for the divisions was the Grand Mufti of Jerusalem, Haj Amin al-Husseini. Al-Husseini lived in Berlin from 1941-1945 as a VIP guest of Hitler.

Post WWII Muslim Brotherhood:

After the fall of the Nazis, the Muslim Brotherhood regrouped in Egypt. The Middle East became incredibly unstable, but the resolve of MB was unwavering in their pursuit of an Islamo Fascist State.

From its early days, the Brotherhood was financed generously by the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, which appreciated its ultra-conservative politics and its virulent hatred of Arab communists. Hermann Eilts, who served as US ambassador to both Saudi Arabia and Egypt, told me that he once encountered Hassan al-Banna in the offices of the Saudi deputy minister of finance in 1948. “He used to come to Saudi Arabia for money,” Eilts said.

Where did they go for the required funds? Apparently, Saudi Arabia.

While this author stresses that the House of Saud and MB had a tense and standoffish relationship, it is not easy to explain away that the Saudi Arabia royals bankrolled the MB. Furthermore, the MB would not have existed without Nazi support and the finances of Jews who met their fate during the Holocaust.

Things for MB remained exceptionally volatile. Al-Banna was killed in 1948. The MB was wanted for war crimes. They were being expelled or exterminated in Egypt. By the mid-1950s they went underground and set up an international structure based out of Germany – financed again, by Saudi Arabia.

From the mid-1950s, the Brotherhood went underground and into exile. Drawing on links with Saudi Arabia, which offered financing and safe haven, the Brotherhood built an international structure. An infrastructure was built in Europe, based in Germany and Switzerland, to help the movement survive. Although this was not the intention, these operations would prove invaluable in providing the Brotherhood a foothold that would, decades later, help it take a leading role in the new Muslim communities in Europe.

But how could they end up in Germany, when the Allied Forces now controlled free Germany after the Nazi regime collapsed in WWII? We find the answer in the MB's capture in Cairo by the British Secret Service (MI6). However, instead of sending them to trial, the British hired them.

at the end of World War II, the Muslim Brotherhood was wanted for war crimes. Their German intelligence handlers were captured in Cairo. The whole net was rolled up by the British Secret Service. Then a horrible thing happened.

Instead of prosecuting the Nazis -- the Muslim Brotherhood -- the British government hired them. They brought all the fugitive Nazi war criminals of arab and Muslim descent into Egypt, and for three years they were trained on a special mission. The British Secret Service wanted to use the fascists of the Muslim Brotherhood to strike down the infant state of Israel in 1948. Only a few people in the Mossad know this, but many of the members of the arab armies and terrorist groups that tried to strangle the infant State of Israel were the arab Nazis of the Muslim Brotherhood.

So how did that work out? The British sold the MB to the CIA. Not only that, some of MB were evacuated to Saudi Arabia.

What the British did then, they sold the arab Nazis to the predecessor of what became the CIA. It may sound stupid; it may sound evil, but it did happen. The idea was that we were going to use the arab Nazis in the Middle East as a counterweight to the arab communists. Just as the Soviet Union was funding arab communists, we would fund the arab Nazis to fight against. and lots of secret classes took place. We kept the Muslim Brotherhood on our payroll.

But the Egyptians became nervous. Nasser ordered all of the Muslim Brotherhood out of Egypt or be imprisoned, and we would execute them all. During the 1950's, the CIA evacuated the Nazis of the Muslim Brotherhood to Saudi Arabia. Now when they arrived in Saudi Arabia, some of the leading lights of the Muslim Brotherhood like Azzam, became the teachers in the Madrasas, the religious schools. and there they combined the doctrines of Nazism with this weird Islamic cult, Wahhabism.

And just like that, the Muslim Brotherhood and their Nazi doctrine were embedded within the schools of Saudi Arabia. They had set up a base in Germany to operate internationally, and were allegedly funded by both the House of Saud and the CIA.

Both the CIA and Saudi Arabia thought it was OK to fund and house a group that found its origins in 1928 with Adolph Hitler?

As an interesting sidenote, John Brennan, the CIA Director from 2013-2017 and from 1996 – 1999 served as the CIA station chief in Saudi Arabia. There were some who said that he had converted to Wahhabism.

A few weeks before the Senate voted to confirm Brennan as CIA director, former FBI agent

John Guandolo revealed that Brennan had, indeed, converted to Wahhabist Islam while he was CIA station chief in Riyadh. Guandolo quoted Brennan as having said that he "marveled at the majesty of the Hajj." The Hajj is the Muslim pilgrimage to Mecca and is reserved only for devout Muslims. Guandolo was quoted as telling a radio interviewer, "Mr. Brennan did convert to Islam when he served in an official capacity on the behalf of the United States in Saudi Arabia." A website that is known to be financed by the CIA and George Soros, Snopes.com, attacked the notion that Brennan is a Wahhabist and ignored the controversy completely. The similarly CIA- and Soros-influenced Wikipedia completely ignored the controversy.

Muslim Brotherhood, Al-Qaeda, ISIS, Iran, Hamas:

The Muslim Brotherhood has had an exceptional rise to power from its early days where Al Banna declared his admiration for Hitler and his fascist Nazi principles. Principles that were born from Prussian militarism, originating from the Hohenzollerns, the prince of Orange. "We must get to the 'oranges' of it all."

The MB were effectively used by the CIA to carry out campaigns in Afghanistan, against the Soviets. They went by the name Maktab al Khidimat il Mujahideen – MaK. This gave rise to Osama Bin Laden, who was taught by the Nazis in Saudi Arabia.

For the Saudis, there was a ruler in charge of Saudi Arabia, and they were the new home of the Muslim Brotherhood, and fascism and extremism were mingled in these schools. and there was a young student who paid attention - - and azzam's student was named Osama Bin Ladin. Osama Bin Ladin was taught by the Nazis of the Muslim Brotherhood who had emigrated to Saudi Arabia.

In 1979 the CIA decided to take the Arab Nazis out of cold storage. The Russians had invaded Afghanistan, so we told the Saudis that we would fund them if they would bring all of the Arab Nazis together and ship them off to Afghanistan to fight the Russians. We had to rename them. We couldn't call them the Muslim Brotherhood because that was too sensitive a name. Its Nazi cast was too known. So we called them the Maktab al Khidimat il Mujahideen, the MaK.

and the CIA lied to Congress and said they didn't know who was on the payroll in Afghanistan, except the Saudis. But it was not true. a small section CIA knew perfectly well that we had once again hired the Arab Nazis and that we were using them to fight our secret wars.

azzam and his assistant, Osama Bin Ladin, rose to some prominence from 1979 to '89, and they won the war. They drove the Russians out of Afghanistan. Our CIA said, "We won, let's go home!" and we left this army of Arab fascists in the field of Afghanistan.

There is no need to revisit every detail of the terror inflicted by radical Islam. What is critical to understand is that its roots grew out of Nazi ideology, and they were aided and abetted by Mi6, CIA and Saudi Arabia. It is also the mother of all Islamist movements.” As the progenitor of the modern Islamist movement, the Muslim Brotherhood (i.e. the Brotherhood) has had a profound influence on the belief system that fuels al-Qaeda, ISIS, and the Islamic Republic of Iran. Despite their disagreements, these groups share ideological underpinnings based on the writings of the late Brotherhood ideologue [Sayyid Qutb](#) and other Brotherhood writers, which shaped these entities into what they are today.

The Brotherhood has also served as a bridge for young Islamists—including bin Laden, al-Baghdadi, and al-Zawahiri—to more violent jihadist groups. Although their execution strategies may differ, at their core, all three groups maintain a shared Islamist vision of establishing a global caliphate. This core is inherently Sunni, anathema to the Shiite Islamic Republic of Iran. Nevertheless, the Brotherhood—and specifically Qutb—has had a profound impact on Iran's development. Had the ‘good guys’ finally found the Oranges of the Middle East?

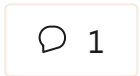
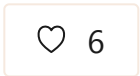

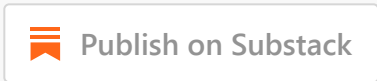
