So far in this series, we've seen Rockefeller's man, John McCloy, go to Nuremberg and oversee the clemency trials which freed numerous Nazi war criminals. We revealed the incredible power that the "*council of the gods*" and "*Legion*" had in terms of influencing government and economic policy. We also revealed McCloy's close relationship with public relations guru, Jean Monnet, who was tasked with structuring the public narrative around the creation of NATO, and the desire to keep NATO nations on a "*war-industrial base*".

## A State of Perpetual War:

We are learning that the Nazis, NATO and the US government may not have been quite as separate as we have believed. In our article, '[Not since 1917 - Part 6](#)' we looked at General Smedley Butler's book, "*War is a racket*". One of his key points was that monopolistic corporations continually profit from war, and yet are never subjected to personal danger themselves. He observed that the ones paying the highest price have no share in the upside.

War rarely benefits the people; but it regularly serves the interests of large corporations.

The CIA report we are spotlighting supports Butler's claim that monopolist's profit from war, and maybe even hope for war. This series is also revealing something else. War is not just a racket, for financial gain; war is a fantastic opportunity to forge alliances; and alliances are a fantastic opportunity to infiltrate nations, particularly at the level of intelligence agencies. The war racket is one thing, but infiltrating another nation, is an entirely different thing.

The Prussian military regime is “*an army that controls nations*”, meaning it must exist within a constant state of war. War leads to treaties; war-time treaties lead to alliances; war-time alliances lead to surveillance. An ongoing war context leads to the need for propaganda and state secrets, ensuring that the people continually remain disconnected from certain information.

One example of a wartime alliance is “[Five Eyes](#)” – which was an evolving agreement to share signals intelligence between Britain, the US, Australia, New Zealand and Canada. [During WW2 intelligence officers from Britain and the US would crouch over bulky radio transmitters listening in on crackling enemy exchanges](#). In the years since then, communications technology has changed drastically; with data gathering becoming easier in the digital age. While it will have evolved, the original 1946 Signals Intelligence agreement between the US and UK still governs intelligence sharing between these five nations.

During WW2, the Nazi regime set about constructing the required global infrastructure and relationships, which would eventually forge a powerful connection with the US, and lead to significant global reach:

At the same time as the west was planning its covert actions against its WWII ally, it also created the formation of the terror club known as NATO, the North Atlantic Treaty Organization. Almost in its entirety it was a Nazi enterprise. Nazi General Reinhard Gehlen, for example, who had headed the Russia Desk in the *Oberkommando der Wehrmacht* (OKW - Hitler's Supreme Headquarters) and a consultant on the Final Solution, was secretly brought to the United States where he would deliver his vast storehouse of previously hidden files on the Soviet Union and then set up the Russia Desk for the soon-to-be-formed CIA. Gehlen would then be returned to postwar Germany where he was put in position as head of Germany's new Bundesnachrichtendienst (BND), the German Secret Intelligence Service.

Reinhard Gehlen was a significant figure in this wartime regime that was being embedded into key nations:

An expert spymaster, Reinhard Gehlen surrendered to the Allies at the end of World War II in order to work with the CIA before founding Germany's modern intelligence service with hundreds of former Nazis like him.

Reinhard Gehlen was born into a family of loyal Prussian militarists on March 3, 1902. Most men in his family had been career army officers for Germany, and Gehlen followed a similar path. As soon as he passed his exams, he was commissioned into the *Reichswehr*, or Reich Defense, under the Weimar Republic leading up to the rise of Hitler.

## (U) Did You Know that the CIA Established the German Intelligence Service?

(U) James Critchfield, a US Army officer turned CIA agent, gathered up the remnants of the Wehrmacht's Fremde Heere Ost (Foreign Armies East) military intelligence (MI) establishment and set them to work on the Soviet intelligence problem. His principal implement was General Reinhard Gehlen, chief of MI on the Russian Front, although over the years it became increasingly difficult to tell who was using whom. Critchfield worked in Pullach, a suburb of Munich, out of a Nazi-era compound known as the Martin-Bormann-Settlement, now BND (German intelligence) headquarters, in Bormann's own office in a building known as the White House.

Were the CIA and the Secret Intelligence Agency in occupied Germany operating as a single entity?

(U) Some relevant dates follow:

- 22 May 1945 - Reinhard Gehlen surrenders to the US Army Counter Intelligence Corps (CIC).
- July 1946 - Gehlen released from US captivity.
- 1946 - CIA begins building a foreign intelligence service in occupied Germany under the name "Organization Gehlen."
- 1947 - Organization Gehlen moves into the Martin-Bormann-Settlement in Pullach by Munich.
- 1949 - With the promulgation of the Federal Republic of Germany, Organization Gehlen begins to serve two masters, the FRG and the CIA.
- 1956 - BND is officially established with Gehlen as its first president.
- 1968 - Gehlen retires as President of the BND.
- 1979 - Reinhard Gehlen dies on 8 June at the age of 77.

Gehlen was certainly no 'international man of mystery'; at least not in the eyes of the CIA:

The group was headed by a lean, balding man in a Lieutenant General's uniform. He immediately demanded that the entire group be sent to the staff in charge, since, he declared, he and his subordinates could provide the American command with information of extraordinary importance. ... When the General gave his name, it made quite an impression.

General Reinhard Gehlen was well known to the heads of the American secret service. In Hitler's General Staff he headed the "Fremde Heere Ost" ("Foreign Armies of the East") Department, directed the spy service in Eastern Europe, and was one of the greatest masters of espionage in Hitler's Reich.

Here is what the West German newspaper Aachener Nachrichten says about this episode: "During the 1945 catastrophe, General Gehlen fled to the West, taking extremely important secret documents with him. He managed to save many top secret lists of German agents operating in the Soviet Union. His ideas made a strong impression upon the heads of the American intelligence, as did the materials which he turned over to them."

Gehlen was sent to the United States capital, Washington, in a special aircraft. He did not remain there long; when all the plans for creating a new spy system at the service of the United States were approved by the Pentagon, he was brought back to West Germany.

Thus Gehlen's career of espionage began. He was serving the United States of America. "The Americans were delighted with his work, and willingly permitted him to increase the number of his workers and to expand his sphere of activity," Aachener Nachrichten said. "The Americans paid all expenses."

"Gehlen received much praise both from his American patrons and from the Bonn Government for the reliability and accuracy of his espionage data" the American journal, New Republic, stated.

Gehlen, quite literally, had designed the US spy network with full approval of the Pentagon!

Despite praise from some American patrons, others were not as excited about the character of those now running US intelligence:

Despite the strict secrecy, some data has gotten into print concerning the personnel of the General's service. It has become known that Gehlen has surrounded himself not only with former intelligence agents from the General Staff, but with all the scum of Hitler's spy system who survived the collapse of the Fascist Reich. He has hired a number of workers from the Gestapo, the special purpose units and the S. S. "Reich Security Administration". The spy-general's closest adviser is a certain Fritz Panzinger, formerly head of the Gestapo in the Baltic Republics while they were occupied by the Fascists.

Gehlen's influence over nations was growing rapidly; almost like a "*tremendous hidden force*", as one British commentator called it:

At first, the work of the Gehlen "bureau" was directed inwards; the American authorities in West Germany needed people working for them in all the units of the political, social and administrative system.

The nature of the work of these people is shown by the admission which a British radio commentator once could not help bursting out with; he called Gehlen's service "political dynamite". "The Gehlen network in West Germany is a tremendous hidden force". this commentator wrote. "It has confidential agents in all the German government bureaus, in the police, the newspapers, the radio stations, the labor unions -- everywhere."

Soon, however, the tentacles of the Gehlen service reached out beyond the boundaries of the FRG -- into the German Democratic Republic and other socialist countries.

After the failure of the attempts to launch a Fascist putsch against the GDR on 17 June 1953, the press of the German Democratic Republic came to the unanimous conclusion that these events were the work of the service of the American agent Gehlen and was the fruit of their criminal activity.

Having been released by the US in 1946, it seemed that Gehlen immediately got busy on the world stage.

Is it possible that Gehlen designed the US intelligence apparatus to have the same sphere of influence as his West German operation? Could the US agencies also place confidential agents inside "government bureaus, in the police, the newspapers, radio stations, and labor unions - everywhere"?

By June 1953, the German Democratic Republic (GDR) referred to Gehlen as an "American agent", and suggested he was the leader behind a Fascist "putsch" which had attempted to overthrow the government. Details of the Gehlen Organization network were coming to light. Many of his agents were arrested, and were open with their information, including agents in Czechoslovakia and Poland. <sup>9</sup>

The scale of infiltration by his fascist regime was incredible:

The Gehlen service, wrote the American journal New Republic, has all the means at its disposal which are known to an intelligence agency of world-wide scope, from petty informers to underground radio transmitters, from secret research laboratories to spy schools and scientific centers in which highly qualified scientists and specialists carefully analyze printed materials published in all the languages of the world.

Of course, not one of the numerous subdivisions of the Gehlen spy system calls itself by its true name. They are all camouflaged as commercial firms or industrial and economic organizations.

The basic offices of the Gehlen spy service include 4,000 experts on military and political affairs. This does not include the army of many thousands of agents scattered in various countries, all the way to the Near and Middle East.

One might think that Gehlen's failed coup in 1953 may have resulted in the end of his espionage career. It appears more like it heralded the beginning of a new phase:

In the spring of 1956, the American authorities transferred Gehlen's agency to the West German government. The head of the agency received the civil service rank of Ministerial Director; he is now subordinate to Chancellor Adenauer through Globke, head of his personal chancellery. The Bonn budget for the 1956-1957 fiscal year earmarked 23,000,000 marks for the maintenance of the Gehlen organization.

While outwardly and formally the Gehlen service is no longer connected with the American authorities, close contact between them is doubtless being maintained.

Was Gehlen the front-man of the invisible Prussian army expanding its espionage network into the entire world after World War 2?

With this benefit of all this hindsight, and given that the Five Eyes Signals Intelligence agreement between the US and Britain was established on **March 5, 1946**, is it conceivable that Five Eyes also had Nazi fingerprints on it? Recall that **Canada joined in 1948, and Australia and New Zealand in 1956** <sup>13</sup>, which was the same year that Gehlen got his 23 million marks. Whatever intention was behind these happenings, the global spy network was expanding.

The post-World War2 period was an incredible time in history. As the Nuremberg clemency trials took place, under the watchful eye of the “*council of the gods*”, the US Army had their watchful eye on the Gehlen Organization:

In meeting with Zimmer in late 1948, Parilli was on the verge of making contact with the Gehlen Organization, the nascent West German intelligence service. Parilli felt that Zimmer could be of benefit in reestablishing ties with many of his wartime German intelligence officials now in the service of the United States. In fact, Parilli’s visit to Germany smoothed the way for Reinhard Gehlen, the head of the German service, to travel to Rome in January 1949. Accompanied by Col. William R. Philp, the US Army officer responsible for the Gehlen Organization, Gehlen met with the American military attaches in Rome, Madrid, and Paris. The meetings in Rome were particularly important because Gehlen wanted to renew his wartime ties with the Vatican.<sup>57</sup> (S)

To be fair, the CIA did raise concerns about Gehlen’s reconnection with Italy, due to the facilitator (Parilli) being a potential double-agent. However, these concerns gradually subsided as the original personalities grew old, and the newly-established bonds of infiltration grew stronger within the camouflaged “*commercial firms*” and “*industrial and economic organizations*”.

Not only did Reinhard Gehlen help establish the CIA and German Secret Intelligence; he was working with the CIA on strategic global policy; even being personally connected with US Army commander, [General Lucian Truscott](#):

Dear General Gehlen:

I have read with great interest your study, Gedanken zur Weltlage, dated 6 July. My senior intelligence officers and I have found it both stimulating and helpful to us in the difficult task of sketching trends over a long period ahead.

It had been my plan to send you in some detail my written comments, but since General Truscott has been here with us during the past week, I have had a chance to discuss your memorandum with him. Accordingly, he will be in touch with you on this and other matters upon his early return to Germany.

CIA Director, Allen Dulles' letter (shown above) was a response to this letter from Gehlen, who outlined his "*Gedanken zur Weltlage*", or "*thoughts on the world situation*":

CONFIDENTIAL

6 July 1953

Dear Mr. Dulles :

General Truscott asked me to write down my general estimate on the political situation of the world and the possible trend for the next years. Since I was away frequently, I had to do it in a very short time. I tried to sketch the general trend as I see it. Please take it as my thoughts based on the available information. I am sure that you will know many of the mentioned problems much better, since outside of the Eastern orbit my knowledge is incomplete.

I would be interested to know if your own opinion is different on one or the other problem.

I thank you for your friendly letter and remain,

The extent of coordination between the US and Germany was breath-taking. Gehlen wasn't just setting up a surveillance network; he was offering the CIA global geopolitical advice.

At its inception, CIA leadership knew that it was running an operation. They understood its role; they knew of the need to maintain a collective "*shut mind*", ensuring that the US people knew "*almost nothing*" about its activities:

### **The Agency Nobody Knows**

In this all-pervasive atmosphere of the shut mind and the distorted fact, Central Intelligence is the key, the vital agency. Yet it is the one agency of government about which the American people are permitted to know almost nothing, the one agency over which their own elected representatives are permitted to have virtually no control. Was it possible that the CIA was running the most sophisticated propaganda program the world had ever seen – against its own people?

The ongoing context of war provided the pretext for this level of surveillance and secrecy. The control after the war wasn't about to loosen. The end of WW2 saw the arrival of numerous peace treaties and trade agreements.

Were trade agreements the new means by which globalist corporations and bankers would control humanity? Is it possible that peace treaties are just trade agreements in disguise?

As we look around the world today, we notice that the threat of war always seems to be present. In recent years, the world was even plunged into a war with an invisible virus that required nations to sign even more agreements.

A special Austrian division of the Gehlen service is promoting the goals of secret preparation, planned for many years, for an anschluss with Austria. This division is called "Sud" (South), and has strongholds in Salzburg, Linz, Graz, Klagenfurt and Vienna. As is the case in other units of this service, the personnel of the Austrian branch are recruited from "specialists" with a Nazi background. One of the leaders of the Austrian division is Wilhelm Hoette, formerly an associate of Kaltenbrunner, chief of the Gestapo.

In particular activity was shown by the Gehlen German-American espionage network in Austria during the counterrevolutionary putsch of the Horthyite underground in Hungary. Austria became a transfer point for the deployment of persons and armaments to support the armed action against the popular democratic system in Hungary. The Gehlen service, operating in close contact with the United States intelligence, undertook to organize this deployment jointly with other imperialistic intelligence agencies. In West Germany people speak openly of Gehlen's participation in the events in Hungary. It was this agency that sent hand grenades disguised as canned goods from the Federal Republic of Germany to Hungary.

Given NATO still exists today, it is worth echoing a question that more people are now contemplating: Did World-War II ever really end?

Whatever the case, the world is still living under numerous modern versions of wartime treaties. These treaties create a realm of international law, and call for the agreement of sovereign nations. Many are questioning whether the unelected leaders within global organizations such as the WEF and the WHO actually have the best interests of people at heart.
