Nobody in this country wants a President in office that is beholden to our enemies. We want a President who will put America first and “Make America Great Again.” Nothing about the Joe Biden administration is putting America first, and certainly nothing they are doing is making America great. This article will not be my typical deep dive that you have become accustomed to. I’m going to instead break down and highlight a series of executive orders which prove that Joe Biden used his presidential office to the benefit of the CCP and his family’s business dealings.

On July 7th, 2022, a story was published discussing Joe Biden selling oil to a CCP-owned oil company. [The Breitbart article](#) showed us the CCP company is linked to Hunter Biden’s firm:

President Joe Biden's administration sold 950,000 barrels of oil from the U.S. Strategic Petroleum Reserve to a Chinese state-owned gas company that has financial ties to a private equity firm cofounded by Hunter Biden, according to a Washington Free Beacon [report](#).

In April, Biden's Department of Energy announced the nearly one million barrel sale to Unipet, which is the trading arm of Sinopec. **Sinopec is wholly owned and operated by the Chinese Communist Party.**

As the *Free Beacon* [reported](#):

Biden is connected to Sinopec through BHR Partners, a private equity firm he cofounded in 2013. BHR bought a \$1.7 billion stake in Sinopec Marketing in 2015. Biden at one point owned a 10 percent stake in BHR Partners through his wholly owned firm, Skaneateles, LLC.

It is unclear whether the younger Biden still has a financial stake in BHR Partners. Biden's White House has repeatedly claimed throughout 2019 and 2020 that Hunter Biden was out of the equity firm, but **Chinese corporate records show he still has a stake in the company.**

This story, which displays massive conflicts of interest, reminded me of an executive order from Trump that is worth a thorough examination. [Executive order 13959](#) is most interesting. It came just 5 days after Joe Biden was declared the winner of the 2020 election. Remember, executive orders aren't just typed up and released within a day. They require thought and planning. It could take days, even weeks from start to finish to have a proper executive order drawn up using the proper authorities in which to legally execute it. This executive order was in the works for a while, and it is no coincidence that it was published after the election was stolen for Joe Biden. You'll see that the Biden Crime family was in the crosshairs of what this executive order would accomplish.

Executive Order 13959 of November 12, 2020

## Addressing the Threat From Securities Investments That Finance Communist Chinese Military Companies

By the authority vested in me as President by the Constitution and the laws of the United States of America, including the International Emergency Economic Powers Act (50 U.S.C. 1701 *et seq.*) (IEEPA), the National Emergencies Act (50 U.S.C. 1601 *et seq.*), and section 301 of title 3, United States Code,

I, DONALD J. TRUMP, President of the United States of America, find that the People's Republic of China (PRC) is increasingly exploiting United States capital to resource and to enable the development and modernization of its military, intelligence, and other security apparatuses, which continues to allow the PRC to **directly threaten the United States homeland and United States forces overseas**, including by developing and deploying weapons of mass destruction, advanced conventional weapons, and **malicious cyber-enabled actions against the United States and its people.**

Key to the development of the PRC's military, intelligence, and other security apparatuses is the country's large, ostensibly private economy. Through the national strategy of Military-Civil Fusion, the PRC increases the size of the country's military-industrial complex by compelling civilian Chinese companies to support its military and intelligence activities. Those companies, though remaining ostensibly private and civilian, **directly support the PRC's military**, intelligence, and security apparatuses and aid in their development and modernization.

At the same time, those companies raise capital by selling securities to United States investors that trade on public exchanges both here and abroad, lobbying United States index providers and funds to include these securities in market offerings, and engaging in other acts to ensure access to United States capital. In that way, the PRC exploits United States investors to finance the development and modernization of its military.

I therefore further find that the PRC's military-industrial complex, by directly supporting the efforts of the PRC's military, intelligence, and other security apparatuses, constitutes an unusual and extraordinary threat, which has its source in substantial part outside the United States, to the national security, foreign policy, and economy of the United States. To protect the United States homeland and the American people, I hereby declare a national emergency with respect to this threat.

“The PRC exploits United States investors to finance the development and modernization of its military.”

Donald Trump and his team knew that Communist Chinese Military Companies (CCMCs) were being funded by American investors and he set out to stop this funding from continuing. Here are the details of what he ordered:

Accordingly, I hereby order:

**Section 1.** (a) The following actions are prohibited:

(i) beginning 9:30 a.m. eastern standard time on January 11, 2021, any transaction in publicly traded securities, or any securities that are derivative of, or are designed to provide investment exposure to such securities, of any Communist Chinese military company as defined in section 4(a)(i) of this order, by any United States person; and

(ii) beginning 9:30 a.m. eastern standard time on the date that is 60 days after a person is determined to be a Communist Chinese military company pursuant to section (4)(a)(ii) or (iii) of this order, any transaction in publicly traded securities, or any securities that are derivative of, or are designed to provide investment exposure to such securities, of that person, by any United States person. □

(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a)(i) of this section, purchases for value or sales made on or before 11:59 p.m. eastern standard time on November 11, 2021, solely to divest, in whole or in part, from securities that any United States person held as of 9:30 a.m. eastern standard time on January 11, 2021, in a Communist Chinese military company as defined in section 4(a)(i) of this order, are permitted.

(c) Notwithstanding subsection (a)(ii) of this section, for a person determined to be a Communist Chinese military company pursuant to section 4(a)(ii) or (iii) of this order, purchases for value or sales made on or before 365 days from the date of such determination, solely to divest, in whole or in part, from securities that any United States person held in such person, as of the date 60 days from the date of such determination, are permitted.

---

The above states that any transactions or investments that provide exposure to CCMCs (that would include primary CCMCs and/or their subsidiaries or parent companies) are prohibited, unless those transactions specifically divest from those companies. Essentially, United States persons could no longer purchase any securities in CCMCs, they could either hold indefinitely or sell.

The executive order continued and defined what a CCMC would consist of.

---

**Sec. 2.** (a) Any transaction by a United States person or within the United States that evades or avoids, has the purpose of evading or avoiding, causes a violation of, or attempts to violate the prohibitions set forth in this order is prohibited.

(b) Any conspiracy formed to violate any of the prohibitions set forth in this order is prohibited.

**Sec. 4. Definitions.** For purposes of this order:

(a) the term “Communist Chinese military company” means

(i) any person that the Secretary of Defense has listed as a Communist Chinese military company operating directly or indirectly in the United States or in any of its territories or possessions pursuant to section 1237 of [Public Law 105-261](#), as amended by section 1233 of [Public Law 106-398](#) and section 1222 of [Public Law 108-375](#), as of the date of this order, and as set forth in the Annex to this order, until such time as the Secretary of Defense removes such person from such list;

(ii) any person that the Secretary of Defense, in consultation with the Secretary of the Treasury, determines is a Communist Chinese military company operating directly or indirectly in the United States or in any of its territories or possessions and therefore lists as such pursuant to section 1237 of [Public Law 105-261](#), as amended by section 1233 of [Public Law 106-398](#) and section 1222 of [Public Law 108-375](#), until such time as the Secretary of Defense removes such person from such list; or

(iii) any person that the Secretary of the Treasury publicly lists as meeting the criteria described in section (a)(ii) of this section, or publicly lists as a subsidiary of a person already determined to be a Communist Chinese military company, until the Secretary of the Treasury determines that such person no longer meets that criteria and removes such person from such list.”

The above tells us that the Secretary of Defense, either by himself or in consultation with the Secretary of the Treasury, determines who fits the definition of a CCMC. The Secretary of the Treasury can also determine the subsidiaries that fit the definition.

(b) the term “entity” means a government or instrumentality of such government, partnership, association, trust, joint venture, corporation, group, subgroup, or other organization;

(c) the term “person” means an individual or entity;

(d) the terms “security” and “securities” include the definition of “security” in section 3(a)(10) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Public Law 73-291, as codified as amended at [15 U.S.C. 78c\(a\)\(10\)](#), except that currency or any note, draft, bill of exchange, or banker's acceptance which has a maturity at the time of issuance of not exceeding 9 months, exclusive of days of grace, or any renewal thereof the maturity of which is likewise limited, shall be a security for purposes of this order.

(e) the term “transaction” means the purchase for value of any publicly traded security; and

You'll see, shortly, why the highlighted companies are important.

On January 13th, Donald Trump issued [Executive Order 13974](#) which amended Executive Order 13959. This amendment is a critical one.

[Executive Order 13974](#) of January 13, 2021

## **Amending [Executive Order 13959](#)—Addressing the Threat From Securities Investments That Finance Communist Chinese Military Companies**

**Section 1.** Section 1(b) and (c) of [Executive Order 13959](#) are amended to read as follows:

“(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a)(i) of this section, any transaction entered into on or before 11:59 p.m. eastern standard time on November 11, 2021, solely to divest, in whole or in part, from securities that any United States person held as of 9:30 a.m. eastern standard time on January 11, 2021, in a Communist Chinese military company as defined in section 4(a)(i) of this order, is permitted.

**Effective at 11:59 p.m. eastern standard time on November 11, 2021, possession of any such securities by a United States person is prohibited.**

(c) Notwithstanding subsection (a)(ii) of this section, for a person determined to be a Communist Chinese military company pursuant to section 4(a)(ii) or (iii) of this order, any transaction entered into on or before 365 days from the date of such determination, solely to divest, in whole or in part, from securities that any United States person held in such person, as of the date 60 days from the date of such determination, is permitted. **Effective at 11:59 p.m. eastern standard time on the date 365 days after the date of such determination, possession of any such securities by a United States person is prohibited.**”

---

The amendment put forth by 13974 stated that the “possession of any such securities by a United States person is prohibited.” Remember that the original executive order only stated that you could no longer purchase these CCMC securities - you could either sell them or possess them indefinitely. Executive order 13974 took that option away and no longer allowed for any ownership of these CCMC securities - it forced divestment.

So why is this important? Why do I think this was targeted at the Biden family?

## **Biden Crime Family**

Hunter Biden's corruption is well-documented, even if censored and covered up by the mainstream media.

On September 23, 2020, Senators Ron Johnson and Chuck Grassley, the chairmen of the Senate Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs Committee (HSGAC) and the Senate Finance Committee, respectively, released a [majority staff report](#) entitled "Hunter Biden, Burisma, and Corruption: The Impact on U.S. Government Policy and Related Concerns." There is plenty of corruption in this report and I urge you to take the time to read through it yourself, but here is the primary takeaway related to China:

The first letter written regarding potential conflicts of interest was sent by Chairman Grassley on Aug. 14, 2019, relating to the **Henniges transaction**.<sup>3</sup> That was an Obama-era Committee on Foreign Investment in the United States (CFIUS) approved transaction which gave control over Henniges, an American maker of anti-vibration technologies with military applications, to a Chinese government-owned aviation company and a China-based investment firm with established ties to the communist Chinese government. One of the companies involved in the Henniges transaction was a billion-dollar private investment fund called **Bohai Harvest RST (BHR)**. **BHR was reportedly formed in November 2013 by a merger between the Chinese government-linked firm Bohai Capital and a U.S. company named Rosemont Seneca Partners. Rosemont Seneca Partners was reportedly formed in 2009 by Hunter Biden, the son of then-Vice President Joe Biden, by Chris Heinz, the stepson of former Secretary of State John Kerry, and by others.**<sup>4</sup>

The direct involvement of Hunter Biden and Heinz in the acquisition of Henniges by the Chinese government creates a potential conflict of interest. **Both are directly related to high-ranking Obama administration officials.** The Department of State, then under Mr. Kerry's leadership, is also a CFIUS member and played a direct role in the decision to approve the Henniges transaction. The appearance of a potential conflict of interest in this case was particularly troubling given Hunter Biden's history of investing in and collaborating with Chinese companies, including at least one that clearly poses significant national security concerns. This history with China precedes and follows the 2015 Henniges transaction. **This report will discuss Hunter Biden's and Devon Archer's corporate entities and their links to the communist Chinese government in more detail.**

In September 2015, BHR joined with a subsidiary of the Aviation Industry Corporation of China (AVIC) to acquire Henniges for \$600 million. AVIC acquired 51 percent of the company, and BHR acquired 49 percent.[12] According to reports, the acquisition of Henniges by BHR and AVIC was the “biggest Chinese investment into US automotive manufacturing assets to date.”[13] Because the acquisition gave Chinese companies direct control of Henniges’ anti-vibration technologies, the transaction was reviewed by CFIUS. CFIUS approved the transaction despite reports that in 2007, years before BHR teamed up with AVIC’s subsidiary, AVIC was reportedly involved in stealing sensitive data regarding the Joint Strike Fighter program. AVIC later reportedly incorporated the stolen data into China’s J-20 and J?31 aircraft.[14]

The three primary ones I want to focus on are Sinopec, Henniges, and China General Nuclear Power Services Corp (CGN).

We already discussed the conflict of interest regarding Joe Biden selling oil to Sinopec. We also know from the above majority staff report that Hunter Biden helped BHR in the acquisition of an AVIC subsidiary - Henniges Automotive. “AVIC was reportedly

involved in stealing sensitive data regarding the Joint Strike Fighter program.” This means Hunter Biden owns part of a CCMC which has stolen sensitive military data.

**China General Nuclear Power Group (CGN)** (Chinese: 中国广核集团), formerly **China Guangdong Nuclear Power Group** (中国广东核电集团), is a Chinese state-owned energy corporation<sup>[3]</sup> under the SASAC of the State Council.

CGN has been sanctioned by the United States for attempting to acquire advanced U.S. nuclear technology to divert to military uses in China.<sup>[4][5]</sup> In November 2020, Donald Trump issued an executive order prohibiting any American company or individual from owning shares in companies that the United States Department of Defense has listed as having links to the People's Liberation Army, which included CGN. CGN's proposals to operate two nuclear plants in the UK have received criticism from MPs as a potential threat to national security.<sup>[6][7]</sup>

- on a related note, BHR is holding cash (generated from the CGN deal) in an amount exceeding RMB60 million in its HK account on behalf of Defaulting LP. Defaulting LP is petitioning for the release of such amounts

So two companies owned by Hunter Biden's BHR, are CCMC companies that have reportedly stolen military and nuclear secrets on behalf of the CCP. The Bidens undoubtedly made lots of money from these deals. Trump listed both AVIC and CGN in his Executive Order 13959:

The amendment put forth by Trump's executive order 13974 would have forced Hunter Biden to divest completely from his ownership of both AVIC and CGN. EO 13974 specifically stated that possession of CCMC securities is prohibited. Read the highlighted parts below one more time:

**Section 1.** Section 1(b) and (c) of [Executive Order 13959](#) are amended to read as follows:

“(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a)(i) of this section, any transaction entered into on or before 11:59 p.m. eastern standard time on November 11, 2021, solely to divest, in whole or in part, from securities that any United States person held as of 9:30 a.m. eastern standard time on January 11, 2021, in a Communist Chinese military company as defined in section 4(a)(i) of this order, is permitted.

**Effective at 11:59 p.m. eastern standard time on November 11, 2021, possession of any such securities by a United States person is prohibited.**

(c) Notwithstanding subsection (a)(ii) of this section, for a person determined to be a Communist Chinese military company pursuant to section 4(a)(ii) or (iii) of this order, any transaction entered into on or before 365 days from the date of such determination, solely to divest, in whole or in part, from securities that any United States person held in such person, as of the date 60 days from the date of such determination, is permitted. **Effective at 11:59 p.m. eastern standard time on the date 365 days after the date of such determination, possession of any such securities by a United States person is prohibited.**”

Trump’s two executive orders addressing the problem of United States persons financing CCMCs is objectively pro-American. How could anybody justify allowing somebody from the United States to finance CCMCs?

That is a question we must now be asking Joe Biden.

## **Biden’s Executive Order**

On June 3rd, 2021, Joe Biden issued [Executive Order 14032](#):

[Executive Order 14032](#) of June 3, 2021

## **Addressing the Threat From Securities Investments That Finance Certain Companies of the People's Republic of China**

I, JOSEPH R. BIDEN JR., President of the United States of America, find that additional steps are necessary to address the national emergency declared in [Executive Order 13959](#) of November 12, 2020 (Addressing the Threat From Securities Investments That Finance Communist Chinese Military Companies), including the threat posed by the military-industrial complex of the People's Republic of China (PRC) and its involvement in military, intelligence, and security research and development programs, and weapons and related equipment production under the PRC's Military-Civil Fusion strategy. In addition, I find that the use of Chinese surveillance technology outside the PRC and the development or use of Chinese surveillance technology to facilitate repression or serious human rights abuse constitute unusual and extraordinary threats, which have their source in whole or substantial part outside the United States, to the national security, foreign policy, and economy of the United States, and I hereby expand the scope of the national emergency declared in [Executive Order 13959](#) to address those threats.

Joe Biden claims that through this executive order he is expanding the scope of the national emergency declared by Trump. The major concern here is what this executive order actually accomplished and how it benefitted his family directly by amending Trump's previous executive orders. Here is what he ordered:

Accordingly, I hereby order as follows:

**Section 1.** Sections 1 through 5 of [Executive Order 13959](#), as amended by [Executive Order 13974](#) of January 13, 2021 (Amending [Executive Order 13959](#)—Addressing the Threat From Securities Investments That Finance Communist Chinese Military Companies), are hereby replaced and superseded in their entirety to read as follows:

**“Section 1.** (a) The following activities by a United States person are prohibited: the purchase or sale of any publicly traded securities, or any publicly traded securities that are derivative of such securities or are designed to provide investment exposure to such securities, of any person listed in the Annex to this order or of any person determined by the Secretary of the Treasury, in consultation with the Secretary of State, and, as the Secretary of the Treasury deems appropriate, the Secretary of Defense:

(i) to operate or have operated in the defense and related materiel sector or the surveillance technology sector of the economy of the PRC; or

(ii) to own or control, or to be owned or controlled by, directly or indirectly, a person who operates or has operated in any sector described in subsection (a)(i) of this section, or a person who is listed in the Annex to this order or who has otherwise been determined to be subject to the prohibitions in subsection (a) of this section.

(b) The prohibitions in subsection (a) of this section shall take effect:

(i) beginning at 12:01 a.m. eastern daylight time on August 2, 2021, with respect to any person listed in the Annex to this order; or

(ii) beginning at 12:01 a.m. eastern daylight time on the date that is 60 days after the date of the determination in subsection (a) of this section with respect to any person not listed in the Annex to this order. □

(c) The purchase or sale of publicly traded securities described in subsection (a) of this section made solely to effect the divestment, in whole or in part, of such securities by a United States person is permitted prior to:

(i) 12:01 a.m. eastern daylight time on June 3, 2022, with respect to any person listed in the Annex to this order; or

(ii) 12:01 a.m. eastern daylight time on the date that is 365 days after the date of the determination in subsection (a) of this section with respect to any person not listed in the Annex to this order.

**Sec. 4.** [Executive Order 13974](#) is hereby revoked in its entirety. The Secretary of the Treasury and the heads of agencies shall take all necessary steps to rescind any orders or prohibitions issued prior to the date of this order implementing or enforcing [Executive Order 13974](#) or the versions of sections 1 through 5 of [Executive Order 13959](#) replaced and superseded by section 1 of this order.

---

Joe Biden revoked executive order 13974 in its entirety. That is the executive order in which Trump ordered “Possession of any such securities by a United States person is prohibited.” The amendments that Joe Biden made did not keep that language. Read the

executive order for yourself. Joe Biden essentially reverted back to Trump's original language where United States persons could no longer purchase any securities in CCMCs, they could either hold indefinitely or sell. There is no longer any language prohibiting possession in its entirety.
